Master's Program in American Studies (Master of Arts)

Admissions Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in American Studies or related subject (e.g. English, Cultural Studies, History)

- If applicants do not hold a bachelor's degree in American Studies, they are required to have

a) successfully completed at <u>least 4 courses</u> that focused on the literature, culture, and/or history of the United States. If applicants' transcripts do not indicate which courses concentrated on the United States, they should enclose copies of relevant course syllabi.

and

b) considerable <u>knowledge of major methodological approaches utilized in literary and</u> <u>cultural studies</u>. Applicants are advised to enclose course syllabi that indicate what types of methodologies were studied.

- The admissions committee may admit exceptional applicants who do not fulfill abovementioned requirements on the condition that they complete additional course work during

the first year of the master's program.

- Proof of English language skills by certificates or another equivalent form of proof

recognized by the examination office (C1), e.g. TOEFL (internet-based: 110 points;

computer-based: 270 points; paper-based: 637 points) or IELTS (overall score 7.0).
