



Horizon Europe: European Research Council (ERC) Starting Grants

Aims	 Funding of frontier research in any field of research: high risk/high gain Funding of individual researchers (Principal Investigators) and their teams
	 Funding of researchers starting an independent research career
Eligibility	Researchers of any nationality and age
	 2-7 years after PhD (extension possible in documented cases such as mater- nity, paternity, long-term illness, national service, clinical training, natural disas- ter, seeking asylum; special rules for MD)
Funding	Funding for up to 5 years
	• Max. 1.5 million EUR (possibly + 1 million EUR for major equipment, research- ers moving from Third Countries or major experimental or field work costs)
Time commitment	 Minimum 50% on the ERC project and minimum 50% in an EU Member State or Horizon Europe Associated Country
Host institution	Located in EU Member State or Horizon Europe Associated Country
Application	Annual call for proposals
	One-stage proposal submission
	 Online via the Funding and Tenders Portal (https://ec.europa.eu/info/funding-tenders/opportunities/portal)
Evaluation	Sole criterion: scientific excellence
	Two-stage evaluation process (peer review)
	Interview at the second step of evaluation
Success rate	• 2023: 14.8%

	Deadline for submission (tba.): approx. October 2024
