4.3) In my opinion the lecture could be improved by:

Have the paper reviewed by two different persons in two sessions.

Self-introduction a little bit too excessive → takes too much time and afterwards do not know the name of (e.g.) the fourth introduced person → but idea with quotes/pictures is good

Writing a "regular" journal article and not a focus analysis.

Maybe making journal topics a theme.

More discussion of other formats (e.g. monographie, M.A./PLD-Thesis, "Sammelband")

- MORE feedback from the lecturer on pieces written
- MORE emphasis on writing the paper instead of the review-process even though that was also interesting and helpful

At the lesson when student discussed the topics of their future analysis and received feedback - it was very long and tiresome. I'm not sure how to improve something in the future, but better to make it shorter somehow.
